
Dear Ms. Burley:

The purpose of this correspondence is to acknowledge receipt at the Central California Agency on March 8, 2000, of your letter of the same day, forwarding the Tribe's proposed constitution. Also enclosed with your letter was Resolution No. R-1-3-06-2000, adopted by the Tribal Council on March 6, 2000. The resolution authorizes submission to the Bureau of Indian Affairs of, and formally requests the calling of an election on, the proposed constitution.

The Central California Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, will conduct a review of the proposed constitution pursuant to the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 967), as amended, and applicable Bureau guidelines. Upon completion of our review, the Agency will submit the proposed constitution with our recommendations to the Regional Director, Pacific Region, for a further review to determine if any provision therein is contrary to applicable laws.
